Half term adventures at **Disneyland Paris**

Hey everyone! I hope you've had a good couple of months.

Since the last magazine, over the Feb half term, we packed the car up and went on an adventure to Disneyland Paris. Can I just say that it was thoroughly enjoyed by everyone.

We have two girls, Florence who has just turned 6 and Harriet who is 3.5, so holidays aren't really holidays are they? They're parenting in a different place. Nevertheless we planned and soaked up every magical moment. We had tears, arguments and moments of frustration, but that's parenting!

When it came to booking, we weighed up all the options (and friends' experiences) and opted to drive. This meant that we could load the car up with home comforts and snacks - not that I was allowed to do any packing! Although it felt a long way, the shuttle was very straightforward and driving in France was so much more enjoyable than on our roads.

We drove to Folkestone on Friday evening after school and with the help of a 3am alarm, bundled the kids into the car and got the 5am shuttle.
